

- Goals of Transforming Nursing Home Care Together (TNT) program:
 - Infection prevention and control education for skilled nursing facility (SNF) infection preventionists and staff.
 - Empower SNF staff to initiate and maintain quality improvement (QI) and quality assurance/performance improvement (QAPI) projects within their facilities.
 - Standardizing infection prevention practices in SNFs across the county.
 - Helping SNFs establish a culture of safety, accountability, and transparency.
- Ultimately, the goal is to improve safety and care for SNF residents, staff, and visitors.



Why QI and QAPI?

Hand Hygiene Adherence Rate



Problem

- Recurrent outbreaks
- Worsening outbreaks
- Public Health/licensing finds infection control gaps

What to do?

 "My staff should know better! We just did an inservice."

BUT

- The answer is not always more education or more in-service.
- Systems fail, people don't fail.

Logistics for Didactic Sessions and Office Hours

Time Commitment

- One didactic session per week for each of eight weeks
 - Main learning sessions.
 - Continuing Education Units.
- One small group session per month
 - Relationship building.
 - Gatherings to share ideas and insights with each other.
- One optional office hour per week
 - Forum to ask questions.
 - Questions need not be limited to that week's lecture content.









Benefits of Participation

- Standardized infection prevention and control education.
- Structure and instruction on quality improvement and QAPI.
- Development of a culture of safety and accountability in SNFs.
- Education on quality reporting practices and transparency by using the National Healthcare Safety Network.





Completion Requirements

- □ Attendance by Designated Participants at 80% (18 of 23 total) of live didactic sessions (virtual) and scoring 80% or higher on the post-session evaluation quizzes.
